Providing High Quality Early Education

Mile High Early Learning offers high quality year-round programs in seven early learning centers that are in some of Denver's poorest neighborhoods.

- 661 infants, toddlers, and preschoolers participated in our Montessori Inspired early learning programs at these centers this past year.
- 94% of families live at or below the Federal Poverty Level (\$24,600 for a family of four).
- Our two drop-in child care centers Denver Warm
 Welcome Court Child Care and Good Beginnings at
 Denver Human Services serve over 7,000 children and families annually.



Serving Infants and Toddlers

As an Early Head Start grantee and partner, Mile High Early Learning collaborates with partners across metro Denver to expand access to and increase the quality of early childhood education. We offer comprehensive services to children in centers and family child care homes - providing not only our premier early learning programming, but also enhanced health, social/emotional, nutrition, and family support.

Engaging Parents and Caregivers



A cornerstone of Mile High Early Learning's philosophy is the guiding principle that parents are their children's first teachers. Through Babies Ready for College, Babies Ready for College: Next Steps, Short & Sweet Book Clubs, and Play & Learn Groups, we serve almost 800 parents and caregivers and their children annually—equipping parents and caregivers with vital information about how children's brains grow and ways to facilitate that growth so that their children will succeed in school.

Training Early Childhood Educators

We recognize that how we support our teachers has direct implications on the quality of their teaching and their ability to do their difficult and important job well. We invest in our teacher workforce through ongoing coaching, training, professional development, and financial support to pursue early childhood degrees – including our Childhood Development Associate (CDA) and Master of Arts in Education and Human Development.
